Food and Beverages Brought into the Facility for Residents

It is the right of the residents of this facility to have food and beverages brought in by family or other visitors however they must be handled in a way to ensure the safety of the resident.

To ensure safety:

- Family members or other visitors may bring the resident food and beverages of their choosing.
- Any food or beverage brought into the facility for resident consumption will be checked by a staff member before being accepted for storage. Any suspicious or obviously contaminated food or beverage will be discarded immediately.
- If a food or fluid that is brought in for resident consumption is contraindicated by the resident's therapeutic diet, education will be provided to the resident and/or resident representative in order that they can make informed choices.
- Family/visitors will be encouraged to bring in only <u>single servings</u> for immediate consumption by the resident.
- Food or beverages brought in from the outside will be labeled with the resident's name, room number and dated by nursing with current date the item was brought to facility for storage.
- Food or beverages may be stored in designated facility pantries, refrigerators or freezers.
 - Foods that do not require refrigeration may be stored in a resident's room or in the designated pantry.
 - Any food or beverage in the original container that is past the manufacturer's expiration date will be discarded by nursing staff.
 - All cooked or prepared food brought in for resident consumption and stored in one of the designated refrigerators/freezers, will be dated when accepted for storage and discarded after 3 days.
