Although a difficult topic to discuss for everyone involved, I want to remind all family members that the Sutter Living Center is a transitional unit and there may come a time that your loved one is found no longer appropriate for the unit. The purpose of the SLC is to provide resident-centered care in a home like setting for those in mid stage dementia. The goal is to help our residents maintain the highest level of functioning as possible. In order to continue to be able to provide the best care of each resident in their stage of dementia, criteria has been set that each resident must meet to be considered appropriate for the SLC. Each resident is monitored on their ability to provide their own personal care, amount of care required from staff members, ability to maneuver within the unit, ability to feed self, level of participation with social and individual activities, and medical/physical needs. Unless something happens unexpectedly to a resident, I do communicate with family members prior to any move in order to make the transition as smooth as possible. If you have any questions about the SLC or the criteria, please do not hesitate to contact me.
