Oakview Medical Care Facility April 2021

Greetings once again! We know you are all frustrated and we share in that sentiment! We feel like we are moving in the right direction and then get setbacks. Because of the positive employee identified on March 24th that puts Oakview in "outbreak" status and we remain closed to regular visitation until we are clear from a positive for 14 days. Staff and residents will continue to be tested 2x per week until we are clear from the outbreak and then after that we just test staff 1x per week. We are still allowed to have compassionate care, end of life visitation and window visits. We are still strongly encouraging visitors to be tested prior to coming into Oakview. Visitors are required to keep masks on **at all times** when entering the building. Visitors must remain 6 feet away from others but can have limited physical contact with the resident they are visiting, if the resident has been vaccinated and the resident has agreed to the contact. The state is updating the guidance, almost on a daily basis, so please stay tuned for updates.

Dietary note of Interest: We will be doing the next cart rotation for the 2nd Quarter (April- June) starting on 4/1/21. This cart rotation is set up to change quarterly so all residents will have the opportunity to be served 1st at various meals throughout the year. This will change for all lunch and supper times as to when your hall cart will go out. For instance if East Hall was 1st after the dining rooms they will be moved to 2nd after the dining rooms for this quarter and if a cart was last they will move to first for this quarter and so on. Also, remember that the resident dining room gets served 1st for all meals. Hope this reminder helps!



Every month, we will include one of the Resident Rights or Responsibilities as written in Oakview's "Residents Rights and Responsibilities" policy. We want our residents and their families to know these important Resident Rights and Responsibilities. If you should have any questions about any of these, please don't hesitate to ask.

B (7) In the case of a resident adjudged incompetent under the laws of a State by a court of competent jurisdiction, the rights of the resident devolve to and are exercised by the resident representative appointed under State law to act on the resident's behalf. The court-appointed resident representative exercises the resident's rights to the extent judged necessary by a court of competent jurisdiction, in accordance with State law.

(i) In the case of a resident representative whose decision-making authority is limited by State law or court appointment, the resident retains the right to make those decision outside the representative's authority

(ii) The residents wishes and preferences must be considered in the exercise of rights by the representative

(iii) To the extent practicable, the resident must be provided with opportunities to participate in the care planning process.
