Happy Summer!



COVID is still an issue for Oakview and Mason County remains in High transmission. We continue to be in and out of outbreak with positive staff. We love to see visitors in the building but please remember there are still restrictions.

**Please remember:**

- Complete screening upon arrival. If the kiosk is not working, manually sign the backup screening log. There is one located at each kiosk. It is also important to check the box indicating whether you have symptoms or not and record your temperature. Visitors with symptoms and/or a fever are not permitted.
- Use hand sanitizer before and after your visit, and throughout your time in the building as needed.
- Wear a well-fitting facemask covering your nose and mouth and physically distance:
  - Around other residents or healthcare personnel, regardless of vaccination status;
  - At all times regardless of vaccination status during times of substantial to high community transmission; and
  - If the resident and/or visitors are at increased risk for severe disease or are unvaccinated not up to date with all recommended vaccine doses during low to moderate community transmission.
- Go directly to the resident's room or designated visitation area. Remain in designated locations on our campus and minimize your movement within the facility.
- Receive education from staff regarding additional PPE use if necessary and appropriate.

Be advised that residents may choose to have close contact including physical touch, but residents who are not up to date with all recommended vaccine doses and their visitors have an increased risk of transmitting the virus.

- ⇒ NO sharing of food and beverages.
- ⇒ Notify facility's Infection Preventionist if you develop symptoms consistent with COVID-19 within 10 days of a visit at 845-5185, extension 236.

"Designated areas" remain to be in the resident room and in the Cherry Blossom room - one family at a time. You may also use the commons area by the fish tank, but again only one family at a time. This is a lovely time to spend outside and you may use the back patio or the courtyard if not being used for a group activity. Visitors are to distance at least 6 feet away from other residents.

We are reserving the Bird Aviary Room for residents and do not want family visiting in this area.

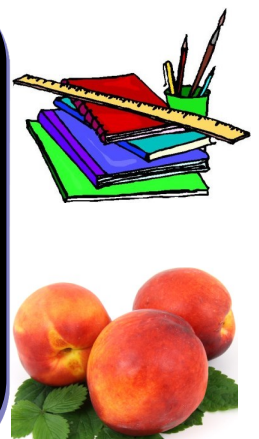
**E. Respect and Dignity. The resident has a right to be treated with respect and dignity, including.**
