Greetings Residents and Families!

As I am writing this Oakview is currently not in Outbreak Status and Mason County's transmission rate, according to the CDC, is reported at 5.3%. This means staff who are fully vaccinated do not have to wear masks and visitors are not required to wear masks. That could change fast. There are signs at the front door and SLC visitor entrance door announcing our current status and requirements. Please watch those signs closely to understand how to enter the building.

Last year at this time Mason County's transmission rate was 33.84%. I would say we are headed in the right direction! But as always, if you are not feeling well please do not visit. Also, if you have been exposed to COVID please wear a mask when visiting your loved one or delay your visit to Oakview.

As a reminder, all visitors continue to be required to screen in and out of the Accushield system. There is an Accushield located in the front lobby for those visiting residents on the general side of Oakview and there is an Accushield located in the vestibule of the visitor entrance of the Sutter Living Center. Please remember to wear your sticker at all times when in the building.

A Friendly TV reminder:

TV's in resident rooms are to be turned down at 10pm for quiet hours so that other residents can have a quiet environment to sleep. Please be courteous of others. We also ask that the volume on TV's that are located in the community areas be kept at a reasonable level for the area. Any issues with this please ask to speak with the charge nurse.

1) Straight Talk Landline. Available at Walmart.

- Straight Talk Prepaid Home Phone Base by Moxee
- Landline, Vtech Cs6114 Cordless Phone, White
- This is a \$15.00/\$30.00 monthly unlimited plan that is able to be up loaded online or via monthly prepaid card.

2) Frontier Land Line

For phone installation a resident/family must call Frontier at 1-888-920-9520 to set up phone service. The phone company must come to Oakview between 8:00am-3:00pm, Monday-Friday. The resident/family is to notify the Maintenance Director at ext. 237 when someone from the phone company will be hooking up the phone.

- Telephone jacks are available in each resident's room
- Telephone instrument must be furnished by the resident or their responsible party
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- All costs associated with the installation, connection and use of a personal telephone are the sole responsibility of the resident or their responsible party.

Hospice Services Offered at Oakview

As a reminder, Oakview MCF has a contract with Harbor Hospice and Elara Caring Hospice to help provide end of life care if requested by the resident and/or family. Hospice assists with symptom management for comfort and quality of life. Hospice care does not take the place of the care provided by Oakview staff members but is in addition and is covered by Medicare/Medicaid. 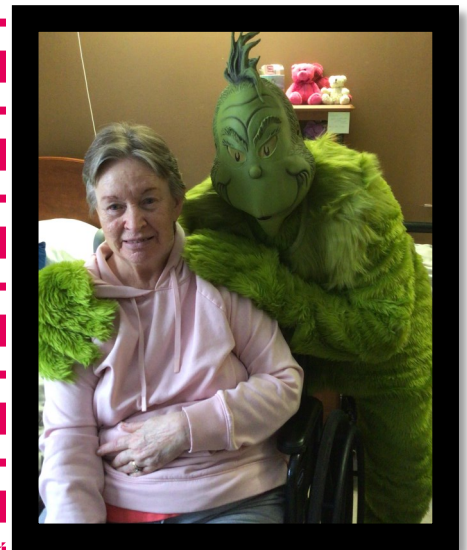
