2024 Elections

Residents in a nursing facility retain the right to vote and are encouraged to if possible. They have a right to exercise his or her rights as a resident of the facility and as a citizen of the United States. The Primary Election will be held on August 6 and the General Election on November 5. Enclosed with the newsletter are the 2024 Michigan Absent Voter Ballot Application, Michigan Voter Registration Application and Change of Address Form, and an informational sheet on applying for an absentee ballot. Please contact Social Services for additional information.

Deadline: Mailed absentee ballots must be received by a local clerk by 8pm on Election Day. Ballots not received by this time will not be counted. Voters are encouraged to mail an absentee ballot at least two weeks before Election Day to avoid potential mailing delays.
