Facility Update: Construction and Laundry Services

Work in the back courtyard area began at the end of August. This renovation will provide a fresh, safe space for residents and families to gather and enjoy special events.

The Laundry Building Project is scheduled to begin on September 2nd. Please note: this project will shut down our facility laundry services for approximately 3-4 weeks. During this time, residents' personal laundry will be handled off-site at a local laundromat. If you would prefer to take your resident's personal laundry home during this period, please contact Megan Hill, Director of Environmental Services, at extension 294.

In addition, we are planning to redesign and replace the sidewalks between the Sutter Living Center and the Laundry Building. During this construction, families will be asked to enter the Sutter Living Center through Oakview's front entrance. More details on this change will be shared soon.

We're also excited to announce that the new Activities Room, Social Work offices and Resident Library should be completed soon! These areas will be operational as quickly as possible, and we're looking forward to sharing these new spaces with you.




