Ingredients:

2-3 chicken breasts or 4 boneless, skinless chicken thighs
2 cups all-purpose flour
2 quarts chicken broth
2 tablespoons oil (avacado or olive oil)
Salt and pepper to taste
optional: carrots, celery, onions, garlic, thyme

Instructions:

1. Prep the chicken: Cook chicken breasts or thighs in oil until browned, then set aside.
2. Make the broth: Add chicken broth to the pot and bring to a boil. Reduce heat and simmer.
3. Make the dumplings: Mix flour, eggs, and water to form a dough. Drop spoonfuls of dough into the boiling broth.
4. Finish the dish: Add cooked chicken back into the pot and season with salt, pepper, and herbs.
